- It was mentioned that some parents noticed the children getting quite rowdy mid movie. They were in and out of the gym for more that just washroom breaks and extremely hyper.
- A suggestion was to have a more controlled canteen. - Our cost is \$6.50 + tax. Anything above that is profit

Poinsettia fundraiser - can purchase from either Kellys or Independent

Kelly's said that we may order too many and were concerned about the condition of the flowers they would be able to provide. As a replacement they suggested pre-cut flowers or mini centerpieces at \$15+tax each.

Independent, we can order 1 week before we would like delivery and there would be a variety of colours to choose from. We would have to arrange the pick up. With this option the council came up with the following costs

\$12 = 5" pot (our cost = \$7 +tax) \$20 = 7" pot (our cost = \$12 + tax) \$25 = 8" pot (our cost = \$20 + tax)
