Principals Report:

We will be using a ministry program called Every Day Mentally Health Classrooms-6 domains of social emotional learning as well as the Supporting Minds document. Staff will be dedicating a time into each day to work on these skills. As well-Wellness Wednesdays-celebrating the power of play for reducing stress/building personal resiliency. Courtney is also integrating a program called the Kindness Curriculum into her French classes that focuses specifically on the relationship building domain of social emotional learning.
