PICTURE DAY IS WED., NOV. 4TH starting at 1:30 p.m.

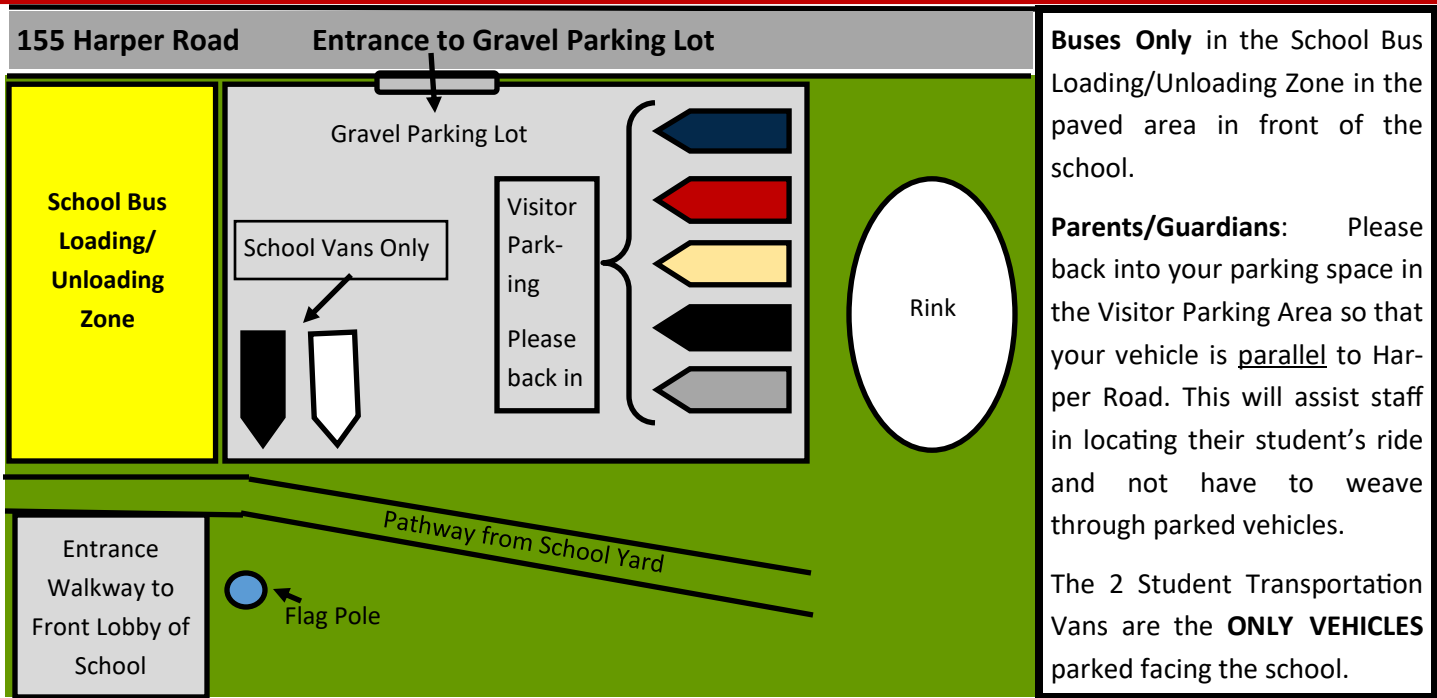
The Remote Learners photo sessions

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Information for Parents/Guardians

Effective immediately we are asking that all vehicles start parking in the gravel parking lot facing the rink as opposed to facing the school. If possible, please back into your spot and wait until your child is delivered to your car.

The 2 Student Transportation Vans are the **ONLY VEHICLES** parked facing the school.

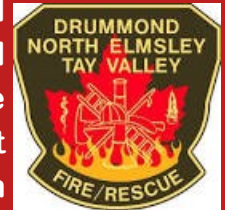
