Memo from the UCBSB for all parents/guardians: At times, during the winter season, it is necessary to cancel school bus transportation due to road conditions. If buses are cancelled, information will be



posted to school Facebook pages, all UCDSB social media platforms, shared with local media outlets and emailed to all parents signed up for My Family Room by 6:15 a.m.

To ensure our schools can adhere to Public Health requirements for students to remain in their assigned cohorts during this period of schools operating during the pandemic, schools in the Upper Canada District School Board will be closed to students when transportation is cancelled.

In this regard, an inclement weather day that results in cancellation of student transportation will be designated as a Remote Learning Day. GTS staff have provided each student with a package of work for continued learning at home. Teachers are available on inclement weather days via email.
