- Step 2. Click on the For Families link and a drop down list will appear
- Step 3. Click on the My Family Room Registration link
- Step 4. Select *Kindergarten*. The instructions on how to register through My Family Room as well as FAQ and STEO (Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario) tabs are all found on this page.

Once your online registration is received you will be contacted by our Office Administrator for instructions on providing Proof of Age and Proof of Residency documents, which are essential for registration. Starting March 1st, all families will be contacted by school staff for introduction and information purposes. Unfortunately we are unable to conduct in-person visits at this time, but the KG Team will be providing a virtual tour of the school to familiarize you and your child with Glen Tay Public School. 
