# **Admin Updates:**

We have been approved for another EA – more info to come soon.

Students setting in to being back at school. So nice to see them – we've missed them so much.

Have noticed with the transition back to in class learning, some little ones are having issues sitting in chairs and staying focused.

Hopeful resolution for smooth transition: providing kids with calming items, bean bag chairs etc. This will come in time.

New staff members – Kristen Walker, Core French and 4/5 Language and Math, Maggie McGlade grade ½ (covering until Samantha McNeil returns in April, Jessica McTavish 2/3 in am, Graeme McTavish grade 5/6.

Significant concerns in student reading levels. Baseline testing administered in all grades. All staff have receiving training in supporting students with phonological awareness and preparing purposeful literacy centers. Special Education small groups started; decodable text have been purchased. Teachers will be given planning time next week to dig deeper into the data and set goals for the next month.

levels for reading are either sticking to where they were last year or dropping (some are almost 2 1/2 levels behind)

Staff received support from boards Speech Language Pathologist to discuss administering Heggerty program (phonological awareness)

Noticing that students need lots of support with number fluency. Staff will be provided with time to plan purposeful math centers and learn about number talks as well as time to look at the Lawson resource.

**Q** (Emma): Wondering what the staff to student ratio is during outside recess time as her children have brought up multiple times that there has been a lot more physical contact/bullying happening during this time?

A (Claire): Currently Primary students have 1 staff member allocated to the 1/2 and 2/3 classes. The 4/5's and 5/6's have 1 staff member per class.

• Starting (hopefully) next week, the 1/2's and 3/4's play areas will be shrunk for better supervision, and they will be separated until intermingling improves.

**Q** (Brittany): Courtney asked about scientists in school? Has Parent Council paid for this already, and when will it start in the school? If we have not paid, can the Parent Council cover the cost to get it up and running?
