Kindergarten Registration for the 2022-2023 school year began on January 10th. Registration is for children who will be 4 years old as of December 31, 2022. Families are to register online or call Glen Tay Public School at 613-267-1909. Online registration is easy:

- Step 2. Click on the *For Families* link and a drop down list will appear
- Step 3. Click on the *My Family Room Registration* link
- Step 4.Select *Kindergarten*. The instructions on how to register through My Family Room as well as FAQ and STEO(Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario) tabs are all found on this page.

Conce your online registration is received you will be contacted by our Office Administrator for instructions on providing Proof of Age and Proof of Residency documents, which are essential for registration. Starting March 1st, all families will be contacted by school staff for introduction and information purposes. Unfortunately we are unable to conduct in-person visits at this time, but the KG Team will be providing a virtual tour of the school to familiarize you and your child with Glen Tay Public School. 


**BLACK HISTORY**

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## School Absence Data and COVID-19

School absence data will be published on Ontario.ca starting January 24th. Effective immediately, if any child or staff member goes home from school with COVID-19 like symptoms, the individual's teacher's name and class will be posted on our school website. For example, " At least one individual associated with Mrs. Smiths Grade 3 class went home with COVID-19-like symptoms today, Monday, January 17, 2022." This system will not report cases in which students presented with symptoms but stayed home.

### $\Rightarrow$ Switching to Remote Instruction and Bus Cancelations

Please make sure to check your email and/or our Facebook page every morning. While switching classes over to remote learning is the last step in a long list of strategies we can employ if a teacher is away, given current staffing shortages, this may need to happen. STEO has also let us know that bus routes may also have to be canceled at the last minute if a driver is sick and no replacement can be found. Cancelations will be posted on the STEO website.
